

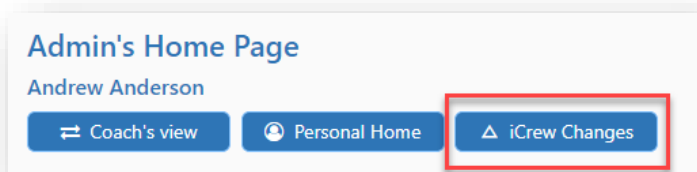


October 2020 New Features Bulletin

Here is a summary of the new features and improvements released during **October 2020**.

Kiosk mode

- iCrew now has support for your club members to make a boat reservation from the **On-the-Water Log** while running in **kiosk mode**. This means you can setup a computer in your boathouse that members can use to make a reservation and to check out to and in from the water, all while the computer is logged into iCrew under a special account. Profile picture upload from club roster

- From the club roster/directory, any club administrator may now upload a picture for any member's profile.

Third block of business hours

- Added a third block of club business hours.

Blocked tiles on Reservation calendar

- The Reservation calendar now shows entries for when reservations are not allowed (based on your club's business hours).

Shortcuts dashboard tiles by club

- The tiles that appear on the **Shortcuts** page can now be customized for your club. [Contact iCrew](#) if you want to change the tiles that appear on the Shortcuts page.

Exposed new member default skill level and boat sizes on club profile

- Added **Default member skill level** and **Default member boat permissions** to the **Reservation Settings** on the Club Profile. These values are assigned to a club member when they register in iCrew.

Added default reservation length that is separate from maximum reservation length

- Added **Default minutes** to the **Reservation Settings** on the Club Profile. Previously, a new reservation length would default to the **Maximum minutes** value.

Allow member in notify list to update damage reports

- Club members whose email address is in the **Damage report notification emails** list on the **Club Profile** can now update any existing damage report.

Allow duration to be specified when making boat reservation

- When making a boat reservation, there is now a **Duration** dropdown list available to specify a duration instead of an end time.

Date range on Session List page

- Added a date range selection on the Sessions List page.

Quick access to COVID-19 screening questionnaire

- Added a thermometer icon link in the page heading area for quick access to the COVID-19 screening questionnaire.

Added team dropdown list to Session List page to filter by team

- The Session List page now includes a team/squad dropdown list to show sessions just for the selected team/squad.

Added new Sidebar of buttons to get to key pages

- Introduced a new **Sidebar** on many pages throughout iCrew when you are on a *large screen* device. The icons on the Sidebar provide quick access to various pages in iCrew.

Allow navigation bar to be expanded and collapsed

- A new button was added to the end of the navigation bar to collapse buttons down to just icons or expand back to full view with text.

Renamed Admin/Coach Home page to Portal

- The Coach's/Admin's Home page was renamed to the **Portal** page.

Set the reservation end time to the check-in time

- When a member checks-in from the water after an independent boat reservation, the reservation end time is set to the check-in time so that if the member finishes earlier than planned, the boat is available immediately for another member to reserve.

Support to notify specified members when a new reservation is made

- You may now specify email addresses to be notified when a new boat reservation is made. See the **Reservation** settings on your **Club** profile.

Member profile update when a member joins a team

- Added functionality to update a member's profile when they join a team/squad. The update to the member's profile is team-specific. Contact iCrew for more information.
