

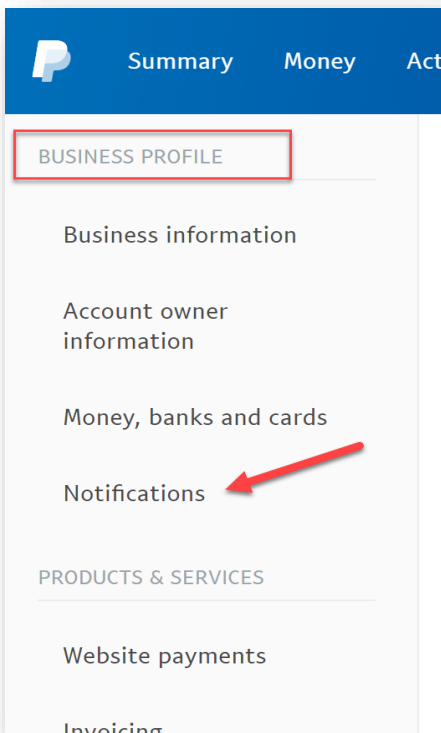
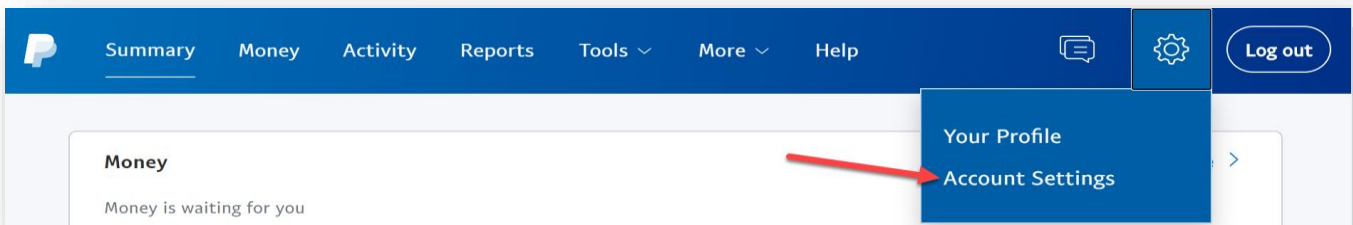
PayPal Instant Payment Notifications

PayPal **Instant Payment Notifications** (IPNs) can facilitate getting a payment marked as paid in iCrew without putting reliance on the club member to click the **Return to Merchant** button in PayPal after making their payment.

Here are the step-by-step instructions for turning on **Instant Payment Notifications** in **PayPal**:

1. Click **Settings** cog in the top bar.
2. Click **Account Settings**.
3. Click **Notifications** under "**Business Profile**" on the left of the page.
4. Click **Update** beside "**Instant payment notifications**."
5. Click **Choose IPN Settings** to specify the listener's URL and activate the listener.
6. Under **Notification URL**, copy/paste this URL: `https://icrew.club/paypalipn`
7. Click **Receive IPN messages (Enabled)** to enable the listener.
8. Click **Save**.

Edit Instant Payment Notification (IPN) settings

PayPal sends IPN messages to the URL that you specify below.

To start receiving IPN messages, enter the notification URL and select **Receive IPN messages**. To stop receiving IPN messages, select **Do not receive IPN messages** below. PayPal continues to generate a notification message for each transaction until you select **Do not receive IPN messages** again (or turn off IPN).
